► Fortunes turn for Shameless star Chris

HIGH society tailors Nicholas Jones - who dress larger than life comedians, soap stars and Premiership footballers - have attracted a new Shameless star.

Instead of dressing stars for their appearances in front of the cameras, the city centre tailors - rated by some style aficionados as the best in the country - saw the cameras coming to them.

A C4 camera crew descended on the shop run by Nicholas Jones and Nick Hartshorn-Evans late last year to film Chris Bisson (pictured below), who plays gay shopkeeper Kash in Shameless, getting suited up.

The controversial character, played by ex-Corrie star Chris, appears in character at the shop in St Ann's Arcade, after a sudden change in his fortunes during the new series of Shameless, which begins tomorrow night on Channel 4.

Nicholas Hartshorn-Evans, tells me: "We do a lot of work for television and have worked with the BBC and ITV in the past but this time a film crew came down from Channel 4 for Shameless.

"Chris Bisson, who plays Kash was in trying on lots of different suits, I can't say why but his luck seems to change in this series."

Nicholas also let slip the names of some of the other celebrity clients who have graced their doors including Peter Kay, soap star Will Mellor and footballers including Ryan Giggs and Joey Barton.
